SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Papers should be written in English.
- Co-authorship is permitted, subject to a limit of maximum two authors per submission.
- Author Name, University/Organization's Name, Paper Title, Email Address and Mobile Number to be stated clearly on the Cover Page of the Paper.
- Abstract: About 350 words; Final Paper: 5000-7000 words.
- The Text should be in Times New Roman, Font Size 12 & Spacing 1.5. The Footnotes should be in Times New Roman, Font Size 10 with Single Spacing.
- One Inch Margin on all sides should be maintained.
- Bluebook 19th Edition format shall be followed for citation.
- No part of the Paper should have been published earlier nor should it be under consideration for publication. Any form of Plagiarism will result in immediate disqualification.
- Participants & selected paper presenters (including Author and Co-author) will be required to fill out the form which will be send through email after intimation of selection of the Paper or upon request for participation in the Seminar.
- In case of Co-authorship at least, one Author must attend the Seminar to present the Paper.
- The registration fee needs to be paid by May 24, 2019.
- Publication of Papers submitted will be subject to the scrutiny of the Publisher.
