



Gold Medals Regulations

1. Gold Medals shall be awarded on the basis of the criteria fixed for the said Gold Medal. For the said Gold Medals based on the certain streams of study, they shall be awarded on the basis of the highest average of grades obtained in the courses of that stream.
2. If two or more students have secured the same grade or grade average, then the marks secured by the students in the courses shall be taken into consideration in awarding the Gold Medals.
3. If two or more students also secure the same marks, then the Gold Medal shall be awarded to the students who has higher grades overall.
4. In case the two contenders have equal overall grades, then the grades in the compulsory courses shall be taken into accounts. In case of the two contenders have equal grades the compulsory course then the performance in co-curricular activities shall be taken into account.
5. The University shall also issue certificates indicating the name of the medal awarded to the students. The University may also consider issuing other certificates of merit or overall conduct ay any Convocation organized by the University.
6. A student who appeared for improvement examination of any courses shall not be eligible any Gold Medal. *
7. A student who has got grace marks of any courses shall not be eligible for any Gold Medal. *
8. A student who has failed in any course and has cleared the course in a repeat examination shall not be eligible for any Gold Medal. *
9. A student who has been fined or has been expelled from the Hostel/University for any act of indiscipline shall not be eligible any Gold Medal.
10. A student to be eligible for the NUSRL Gold Medal and the Chancellor Gold Medal for B.A. LL.B (Hons.); and the Visitor Gold Medal for LL.M. (One-year), only, when he/she appeared in the first examination held for his/her batch in the entire course and secured the highest CGPA.
11. A student of B.A. LL.B (Hons.) and the LL.M. (One-year), shall be eligible for the Gold Medal only when he/she appeared in the first examination held for his/her batch in that particular subject and secured the highest marks.
12. Gold Medal shall be awarded to deserving students at the Convocation. The criteria shall include following:
 - (i) For B.A LL.B. (Hons.), CGPA calculated at the end of 5th year as per NUSRL Rules of Examination, 2010.



- (ii) For LL.M (One-year), CGPA calculated at the end of 2nd Semester as per NUSRL Rules of Examination, 2010.

The University awards the following Gold Medals:

- (i) **NUSRL Gold Medal:** The NUSRL Gold Medal shall be awarded to the first rank holder student in B.A. LL.B. (Hons) who secured the highest CGPA in the first exam conducted by the University for that batch in the entire course by taking the programme as a whole.
- (ii) **The Vistor Gold Medal:** The NUSRL Gold Medal shall be awarded to the first rank holder student in LL.M. (One-year) who secured the highest CGPA in the first exam conducted by the University for that batch in the entire course by taking the programme as a whole.
- (iii) **The Chancellor Gold Medal:** The Chancellor Gold Medal shall be awarded the second rank holder student in B.A. LL.B. (Hons) who secured the highest CGPA in the first exam conducted by the University for that batch in the entire course by taking the programme as a whole.
- (iv) **The Rector Gold Medal:** The Rector Gold Medal shall be awarded to the student who secured the highest score in the first exam conducted by the University for that Batch in the subject decided by the Gold Medal Committee time to time before the conduction of the Convocation.
- (v) **Sponsored Gold Medal:** The University shall award the sponsored Gold Medals to the students who secured the highest score in the first exam conducted by the University for that Batch in the subject decided by the Sponsor time to time before the conduction of the Convocation.
