Applications are invited from eligible candidates for the Special Fellowship Programme Implementation “One Year Fellowship on Rolling of Principles of Diversion”, 2024-2025. The objective of the Fellowship program is to equip fresh law graduates with the knowledge and practical experience to support the implementation of the principle of diversion, minimizing the reliance on formal judicial processes and promoting rehabilitation in Jharkhand's juvenile justice system. The Fellowship programme details are given below:

Eligibility Criteria:

- A law graduate (who completed the graduation within last two years of the date of advertisement) graduated from any recognized university.
- Demonstrated interest in juvenile justice, child rights, or related fields.
- Strong understanding of the laws relating to children, particularly the JJ Act, 2015.
- Self-motivated, proactive, and committed to working in challenging environments.

Age Limit: The applicant's age shall be between 25-30 years as on notification published in the University Website. For candidates belonging to SC/ST category, the maximum age limit shall be 35 years

Duty Station /Location – The Fellows will be stationed at Ranchi, but needs to undertake field visits to different districts for field activities as and when required.

The **One-Year Fellowship on Rolling of Principle of Diversion** 2024-2025 will commence from December 2024. The last date for submission on online application is 10th December, 2024. The candidate must submit their CV along with the proof of their qualification to Centre for Child Rights, National University of Study and Research in law, Ranchi at ccr@nusrlranchi.ac.in, copy to registrar@nusrlranchi.ac.in. Application other than online mode shall not be accepted .

5. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview. **Interview date** shall be notified by mail.
6. No TA/DA for attending the interview is admissible.
